Please drop off donations at the Georgia United Branch nearest you or make a \$1 donation and we'll purchase a food item for you. All members who donate will be entered into a drawing to win an iPad.

**The most requested/needed items are:**

- Peanut butter
- Canned tuna & chicken
- Canned fruit & vegetables
- Canned soups, stews and pasta
- 100% fruit juice
- Boxed pasta and rice

For the last two years, we encouraged all Georgia United Branches to collect canned goods for local food banks. Our 2013 goal was to surpass 9 tons of food (18,000+ cans) during the 2 month period and Georgia United almost **DOUBLED** our goal and collected (31,839 cans) 15 tons! (Using these Metrics: One 16 oz. can or box = 1 lb.; \$1.00 donation= 1 lb.; 1 ton = 2,000 pounds). This year, February 1 – March 31, we'd like to top that. **Will you help us?**
